

DECLARATION OF DISASTER
PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the City of Splendora, in the County of Montgomery County, Texas on the 16th day of March 2020, has suffered widespread or severe damage, injury, or loss of life or property (or there is imminent threat of same) resulting from

COVID-19 (Coronavirus), and

WHEREAS, the Mayor of the City of Splendora has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF SPLENDORA:

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for City of Splendora pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.


2. Pursuant to §418.018(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the City Council of Splendora.

3. Pursuant to §418.018(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.

4. Pursuant to §418.018(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the City Emergency Operations Plan.

5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
