DEFERRED DISPOSITION REQUESTS

A defendant is eligible for Deferred Disposition for a moving/non-moving violation if:

(1) the defendant shows proof of valid Driver's License

(2) the defendant pays in full at the time of the request - all court cost and special expense fee (which is equal to the window fine)

(3) the defendant is at least 25 years of age

(4) the defendant has not been granted Deferred within twelve (12) months of the date of request in Splendora or any other jurisdiction, and

(5) not be convicted of any offense of a similar nature within the City of Splendora within the last twelve (12) months

A defendant is eligible for Deferred Disposition for Failure to Maintain Financial Responsibility:

- (1) defendant must submit proof of valid insurance listing the Defendant as a driver on the policy
- (2) pay the special expense fee (fine amount at time of request) and courts costs;
- (3) maintain valid insurance (to be verified at the end of the deferral period), and
- (4) not be convicted of any offense of a similar nature within the City of Splendora

A defendant is not eligible for Deferred Disposition for a moving/non-moving violation if:

- (1) the driver is the holder of a Commercial Driver's License
- (2) the offense occurred in a construction or maintenance work zone when workers are present
- (3) the defendant was involved in an accident
- (4) the offense involves passing a school bus
- (5) the offense involves failing to obey school crossing guard
- (6) the offense involves speeding in excess of 25mph over the posted speed limit in excess of 80 mph
- (7) the offense involves a violation of the Alcohol Beverage Code
- (8) the offense involves violations of Chapter 161 of the Texas Health and Safety Code (Tobacco violations)
- (9) the offense involves personal complaints, or
- (10) the defendant has violations in "Warrant Status"

The deferral period shall be 90 days.

To request Deferred Disposition, payment of a special expense fee equal to the fine amount will be required. Please send your request via email at court@cityofsplendora.org or mail to P. O. Box 1087, Splendora, Texas 77372.

Payment can be made by phone (1-888-439-1900; online (www.texasonlinerecords.com), by mail (check, money order or cashier's check to P. O. Box 1087, Splendora, Texas 77372), or insert in the City's drop box on the East side of City Hall at 26090 FM 2090 E, Splendora, Texas 77372.

Once the request and payment have been received, a Deferred Disposition Order will be mailed to you that will have to be returned prior to the end of the deferral period.

At the end of the deferral period, upon receipt of the Deferred Disposition Order and if the defendant has not received any new citations, this citation will be dismissed and cleared from your driving record.
